The Grace of the Holy Spirit in Human Consciousness

- I Know I am Different because I feel Different
- Spirit images: Fire, Water, Oil, Wind (Breath), Blood, Wine
- The Permeation of the Soul (Psyche + Spirit) Functions
- The Psyche: *Longing* born of Religious Love (Hope)for Relationship with the Unknown Mystery of God (Father)
- The Cognitive (intellectual) Functions: *Knowing* born of Religious Love (Faith) from the Word (Son)
- The Will (volitional) Function: *Acting* born of Religious Love (Charity) from the Holy Spirit
- My Consciousness is Different: I am religiously in-love

Religious Experience

- "Wired for God" due to Constitutive Spiritual Function
- When God Moves: the Importance of the Feeling Psyche
- The Distinction of Religious Experience: Awe and Wonder
- The Change of the Awareness Horizon
- The Accommodation of God to our Humanness (Grace)
- The Longing born of Religious Love (Hope) for Mystery
- The Knowing born of Religious Love (Faith)
- The Acting born of Religious Love (Charity)
- The Rising from the Dead Relationship

A New Creation: The Big Seven

- The Newness is real: My restored *Relationship with God* is a Rising from the Dead
- God comes bearing Gifts
- The Transformed Human by **Theological Virtue** (Powers)
- The Transformed Life-force (psychic energy) by Hope
- The Transformed Intelligence by Faith
- The Transformed Will by Charity
- Charity as the Form of Cardinal Moral Virtue
- Prudence: Love's Discretion
- Justice: Love's Fairness
- Fortitude: Love's Courage
- Temperance: Love's Moderation
