May the Grace and Mercy of Christ Jesus be with you all.

As Phil has pointed out, my personal revelations do not necessarily represent the views of Phil or Shalom Place, nor am I wanting to challenge or replace Church theology in any way. Also, I have no intention of degrading anybody's spiritual path. Each of us must have our own direct experiences. After praying about the discussions on this thread, I am led to share this with you.

False Gods and the Lord of All Lords

From the minute I heard the Hare Krishna mantra many years ago, I fell in love with it. It was especially easy chanting mantras at Muktananda's ashrams in New York and India as these places are pulsating with Shakti (an energy attributed to Kali and confounded with kundalini). During a month-long retreat in the India ashram, I spent many hours chanting the Hare Krishna mantra. After a few weeks of chanting on and off, Krishna appeared to me. He came to me in the form of a dark-skinned young boy. His 'form' appeared to be made of liquid love. He moved with such grace and beauty, I felt like I could pass out! I was stunned at his dazzling youth and radiance.

A few years ago when I was still quite convinced that 'all paths lead to God,' I ordered a book about a form of Tantric Buddhism. When the book came in, I was so very eager to read it, but it was late at night, and I was too tired to begin reading. So I placed the book up to my forehead, and prayed with intense passion that I would receive the 'highest truth' presented in this book. Without expecting *anything* at all to happen, I laid down in bed and while still awake, had an incredible experience. I felt an invisible hand placed on my chest, an opening at my heart charka, and a hole open up at the top of my head. Light/energy was flowing wilding out of the top of my head. This event transported me into another world. I 'saw' the most exquisitely beautiful 'world' with beings, rapturous lovers, who seemed half human/ half spirit. Later when I read some of the book, I realized I had visited this 'heavenly' place; again I was stunned at the sublime beauty of this place.

I have had many other direct encounters with what, at the time, seemed like true divinity. I felt like the luckiest person in the world when I had a sustained vision of the Blue Pearl and also when I directly experienced the 'bliss body.' My encounters of the deities, energies, and experiences of the supernatural world seemed quite sacred to me. Insofar as these encounters are exquisitely, supremely, heart-stoppingly sublime and beautiful, and beyond reaches of ordinary consciousness, they seemed worthy of worship in the context of what I had known.

However, it was not until I came into direct contact with Christ that I *now* realize that all those deities are *false gods.* The highest truth in any book about Hindu (and their Buddhist faces) gods/goddesses is that THERE IS A SPIRITUAL WORLD OF FALSE GODS AND GODDESSES. This is nothing to celebrate. David Hawkins has written that in the astral realm, there are "worlds without number" and each one has a 'god' who maintains lordship over that world. In my experience, the Hindu Gods/goddesses are such beings in the astral realm. Even though some of these worlds are breath-taking, captivating, seductive, beautiful places, <u>there is nothing</u>

holy about the spiritual world. The spiritual world is a kind of carnival of delights. The energy they transmit will feel ecstatic and it will feel divine, but it is a lie.

The exhilarating Shakti I have experienced in the ashrams and meditations centers I've been in, where Shiva and Shakti are worshipped, is distinctly different from the Holy Spirit. They are NOT two forms of the same one Power of God. Nor are they two different words to describe the same thing. I am telling you the truth, they are as different as Light is from darkness.

I didn't see this reality until I came more fully into the Christ Body. When I saw and felt Christ's Love directly, I realized that all those energies and deities are FALSE GODS. Furthermore, they are anti-Christs insofar as they will turn seekers away from God by presenting themselves as worthy of worship. These false gods will say 'all the right things' and appeal emotionally to your heart. Nobody would consciously choose to worship the anti-Christ if they knew what it really was!! They will feed you real truths MIXED IN WITH LIES and empower you with tremendous, expansive energy. Those who bow to these energies will be given other-worldly riches beyond your wildest dreams!

I have seen and felt false gods and their virtually irresistible magic. Christ is different.

When you see the Beauty and Majesty of Christ Jesus, you will know what it means that He is the Lord of all lords! That He alone is the King of all kings....everything else is a lesser god.

Upon feeling the Divine Love of Christ, you will realize that all searching is over.

When Christ Jesus reveals Himself to you directly, will see that everything you have ever done, thought, or strived for, and every moment of every lifetime that you've lived was for the sake of coming to Him.

In His Presence, all human variance will reduce to ZERO. You will have no choice but to fall on your face with reverence. You do not know the meaning of reverence until you come to Christ.

Nothing exists that is like Christ.

All siddhis, powers, shaktipat, etheric travels, energetic mergings, and supernatural occurrences become *child's play* in the face of Christ's Mission--to save a broken humanity.

When He reveals Himself to you, you will not stop crying with sheer gratitude that you have been found! In full awareness of Christ living inside you, you will regard all suffering and obstacles as opportunities to grow deeper in faith.

Truthfully, when you begin being purified by Christ's humility, all other spiritual energies will literally feel like DIRT on clean hands!

Other spiritual teachers do not preach Christ Risen because they don't know Him! These leaders can and do inspire one to move beyond their physical identifications and their suffering egos. They will ignite and move kundalini in your body and you will have many 'spiritual' and fantastic experiences. Gurus do point one to God insofar as God is beyond the merely physical plane. However, they are, AT BEST, stepping stones for one's further growth in Christ. Humanity's highest call is to come to Christ and be purified of everything that pulls away from Him. In my experience, this purification includes being rid of all interchanges with all forms of false gods.

No Compromising in Christ

Christ has been showing me that there is no compromising the Truth about who He is and WHO HE IS NOT. At this point, engaging in a 'debating society' of opposing points of view or clever arguments is no longer following His Grace. I will not engage those energies which are completely closed to the reality of what I am presenting about the distinctiveness of Christ. I can only say that if you want to test this idea, make it *your* genuine intention.

There is no compromising about who Christ is NOT. Christ is not Kali, Shiva, Shakti, or Krishna. I have experienced these deities firsthand and they are deities *disguised as divinity.* The energy they bestow on their followers takes one to worlds from which I can see some might never return.

You don't need to 'test the spirits.' Just test your LOGIC. Kali, equated with all forms of Hindu gods, is a deity who is worshipped as God, but she has a dual nature. She is both 'good' and evil. It is not a secret, in general, that the energy of Kali can be manipulated to perform black magic! Books on the power of Kali warn about using her power in evil ways. There are actually REMINDERS of the 'very bad karma' that one will incur if they use Kali to hurt others!

Please note this startling contrast: There is nothing in the Christian literature that says the *Holy Spirit* can be manipulated to execute evil acts! There are no incantations, secret mantras, or esoteric rituals that will incite Christ to hurt or destroy other people.

Christ cannot be used in this way because the Holy Spirit is Holy! Kali is NOT of a Holy source. While her "split off" bad can be worshipped as the "Holy Mother" in some who call on this energy, this does not negate the essence of who she is! One could rationalize and say that those pure of heart are worshipping only the *good* aspects of Kali, the "Holy Mother," and so they are *really* in touch with God the Divine. This is an interesting speculation. At the same time, one can say that the 'evil' aspects of Kali are split off through disguise and/or remain latent in that same seeker who is calling on Kali, the "Holy Mother" side.

In *my experience* of merging with Kali, I could see the latter was true. I have learned that even the pure of heart can be deceived. This is not a judgment about one's spiritual *destination,* just a fact of life.

Many will say that I am imaginative, delusional, narrow-minded, fanatical, or arrogant. None of this matters because it's not a 'personal' thing. It's much bigger than that.

Christ is Beyond Enlightenment

It is my understanding that most enlightened gurus are leading people astray because they don't preach the exclusivity of Christ. They will say Jesus taught the path to enlightenment. They have bought into the illusion that enlightenment is the

end of the road. It is my understanding that enlightened teachers who don't preach Christ don't have the experience of the Holy Spirit. They don't preach Christ because they don't know the Father. They don't talk about Jesus as the incarnation of God because they don't know the new reality that He created, the Christ Body. Enlightened gurus know unity consciousness and the powers attendant to those who are inclined to 'play God' with the help of the energies or deities they summon.

By now we have all awakened to the truth that enlightenment is not the end of human spiritual evolution. We know this is so because enlightened beings are fully capable of abuses. It takes a deep surrender to Christ to move beyond the state of enlightenment and learn about the Father's will while living in the body. How do I know this?

At age 25, I was catapulted for into enlightenment just about 12 hours after receiving shaktipat. For a few minutes, I could literally see and feel that all of creation was One. I could see that the manifest world of form was clearly an illusion. People and objects only appeared as separate. Every 'point' in time and space was equidistant from every other 'point.' Unity consciousness is indeed a sacred experience because you can see directly that God exists in all things and is responsible for the created metaphysical order. One merges into this created order and feels no different from this One-ness. Many times, this is the no-self state returned to me over the years. This is where the seer, the seen, and the process of seeing become one. At this point, since there is no 'other,' there seems to be nothing to worship, no 'thou.' This unbound consciousness, totally free and complete, is not, by itself, the fullness of God the Father. Enlightened people have spouses, mortgages, children, dogs, etc. with whom to relate. While it feels like you don't exist, like energy is just moving through you without any attachments, the Holy Spirit can still be called upon as the Teacher.

This is a free will choice you can make at every moment. We are called to remain in Christ, and through our free will, surrender to His will. Christ is both inside the One and beyond the One as he slices through the created spiritual order. Christ is the cosmically ordained carrier of a new Divine Order, which is underway. (Is this in the Bible somewhere?)

Currently, I experience unity consciousness, the Oneness of All, as the backdrop of my reality. I see the world as a throbbing mass of consciousness. As people move in and out of my field of view, I recognize all of them as equally part of my own Self. They are more like appendages to my own body than separate people (though I do an adequate job acting like they are distinct ; -)). As I hear people speak to me, I know that my own Self is saying something to me. Right now, this message you are reading is just another 'mouthpiece' of yours talking right back at you. Every so often, especially on retreat, a more radical form of non-dualism will break through my consciousness. At these times, I am not even in my body. I do not exist at all in this form. I am completely merged with creation. I am surprised when I start to move my limbs that they even belong to me or that I can remember how to move them. While I respect this dimension of reality and am awestruck at the Mystery, this dimension of reality is not really interesting to me anymore because, at this moment, Christ needs me in the Body. Christ needs 'worker bees' not a Queen Bee.

Once you become more merged into Christ's Body, non-duality recedes as a backdrop as you see Christ laying the foundation for the Divine Order. Here, you realize Christ and His angels are working all the time! Everything has energy behind it-- every word, every thought, everything you type, and every intention, is either pulling up to Christ or down by those energies that oppose Christ. When you see this, inviting Christ to grow in you is like the air you breath.

The Flow of Grace and Free Will

Those who call on the Highest Truth will become supremely humble. They will resonate with Christ, call on Christ, and He will live inside them. Despite all resistances, suffering, and periods of doubt and dryness, these souls will primarily *want* to cooperate with Christ's purification. Christ will not violate the free will of others. He will not go where He is not invited, but He will rush in with tremendous Love and forgiveness where He is invited. As carriers of the Christ 'energy,' we too must follow the flow of grace being careful not to go where He is not invited.

I describe how I dramatically learned about this law of free will in my paper (p. 11). I prayed in Jesus' Name for a family of three who explicitly worship Kali. Without any warning, I felt three full-body agonizing blows hit me, one for each member of the family. It was like my prayers literally hit me like a boomerang. I experienced the instantaneous repulsion of Christ's Love from where it is not wanted!

I had no frame of reference for this bizarre occurrence and no expectations for such an event. I was under the illusion that 'all paths lead to God' and truly cared about this family whom I regarded as 'spiritual.' The experience was given to me to illustrate that there is an energetic rejection of Christ by those who call on the dark energies, in this case Kali.

Despite the *claim* that Kali is God, and the claim that it doesn't matter what name you attribute to God as long as you have a good heart, <u>there is an unseen energetic</u> <u>domain which distinguishes Christ's energy from other spiritual forces that mix with humanity</u>. Those who consciously call on energies of false gods like Kali will be transformed at the level of their etheric bodies. In a real sense, they will become carriers of this energy.

This is a fact, and no amount of discussion, desire for religious harmony, or wishful thinking will change it.

I certainly didn't feel or look or act like a demon when I called on Kali and merged with her, on the contrary. Because of my primary dedication to serving God, it was not until Christ began purifying me that I realized what I had done, that I had invited dark energies to live in me.

Christ has made it clear to me: there are places where He will not go. Therefore, in following the flow of Grace as I experience it (and recognizing that I am not perfect), I will only respond to comments on this forum from those who are ready to return to Christ Jesus, who want to share and exchange about His Love in their lives, or who want to know Him more directly.

I've done my best to explain why I feel this way, and I beg God's forgiveness if anything I've said is untrue, but I will not engage those energies which insist 'all paths lead to god' and deny the possibility of 'false gods/anti-Christs' operating through seemingly benign religious forms. P.S. I have to tell you. After I wrote this letter, I sat to pray and asked God if He had a word for me or the discussants about this topic. God spoke to me, "Timothy 4...2". Honestly, in the name of my Savior, I had <u>no idea</u> what this scripture was or the content of any of this letter.
