

- Buddhism Dukkha. Samsara






What is Sin?

- A power at work in the world.
- A social situation. Values, movements and tendencies in the culture that do harm to human life and creation -- e.g., injustice.
- A personal act. "Offense against God as well as a fault against reason, truth, and right conscience." CCC
- A condition of disharmony and woundedness that we're born into because of non-love. (Original Sin)

False Self System

- Conditioning we develop to compensate for the pain and disharmony of Original Sin and Social Sin.
 not a real "self"
- Inner commitment to "make oneself OK" by having, getting, associating-with, doing, being better-than...
- Pervades self-image, emotion, memory, imagination (psyche).
- Biases the functioning of the human spirit (inauthenticity).
- Inherently suspicious of grace/unconditional love.
- Vulnerable to evil spirit.



Origin of the False Self System

Perception of conditionally loving environment

- one is conditionally loveable and acceptable
- shame, fear, resentment
- → Defensive contraction of energy and attention away from the environment.
 - inner disharmony; ego-centricity; loss of sense of divine within.
- ◆ Internalization of "rules" on "how to be OK" from the environment.
 - mind focused on "how to be OK?" issues.
