

#### What did Paul notice?

<sup>1</sup> While Apollos was at Corinth, Paul took the road through the interior and arrived at Ephesus. There he found some disciples <sup>2</sup> and asked them, "Did you receive the Holy Spirit when you believed?"

They answered, "No, we have not even heard that there is a Holy Spirit."

<sup>3</sup> So Paul asked, "Then what baptism did you receive?" "John's baptism," they replied.

<sup>2</sup> So Paul asked, "Then what baptism did you receive?"

"John's baptism," they replied.

4 Paul said, "John's baptism was a baptism of repentance. He told the people to believe in the one coming after him, that is, in Jesus." • On hearing this, they were baptized into the name of the Lord Jesus.

When Paul placed his hands on them, the Holy Spirit came on them, and they spoke in tongues and prophesied. <sup>2</sup> There were about twelve men in all. (Acts 19)

#### Spirit

Hebrew = "ruach" Greek = "pneuma"

- \* spirit \* breath \* wind \* that which gives life and animation to something
- \* Holy Spirit as God's Spirit, Breath, Wind -- communicating God's life.

### Biblical teaching

- $\clubsuit$  Joel 3: 1-2 outpouring of the Spirit.
- In. 14-16: Spirit as another advocate (paracletos); abides with us; will be with us and in us forever; sent in Jesus' name to remind us of his teaching and teach us all things; sent from the Father; Spirit of truth, who testifies on Jesus' behalf; show worldly standards of righteousness and judgement to be wrong; guide us into all truth; prophesy; glorify Jesus.
- Lk. 11: 9 God delights in giving us the Spirit.
- $\mbox{\ensuremath{\$}}\mbox{\ensuremath{\$}}\mbox{\ensuremath{$I$}}$  Cor. 2: 11 Joins our human spirit with depths of God that we might understand what God has given us.
- 1 John 4: 13 "This is how we know that we remain in him and he in us, that he has given us of his Spirit."
   John 16: ", it is better for you that I go. For if I do not go, the Advocate will not come to you. But if I go, I will send him to you.
