A few terms

- Salvation redemption; deliverance from evil or harm; beginning of new life in God.
- Conversion to turn one's life around; away from sin toward God; to repent of the old and open to the new.
- Theosis deification; sanctification; ongoing conversion leading to transformation by grace.

- Souring by bacteria; wild yeasts.
- Rackings re-bottle; slower fermentation; sediment settles; liquid clearing.
- "New wineskin" for new wine.
- Mature wine flavorful, full-bodied, transparent, invigorating.
